Loch Bike Path. The problem areas are the path. Mr. Rogers believes that the upkeep of the path is the most important. Below are the major concerns:

The general landscaping needs upkeep. The trees and weeds are overgrown.

The path itself is in need of resurfacing, and there are a few areas where tree roots are uprooting the pavement.

There is also a sink hole that has been repaired in the past, but needs to be fixed again.

Also, there is an area of the path that is covered in mud due to poor drainage. An alternative path on the grass has been made from the foot traffic of users avoiding the area.

The bridge on the path is also in need of repairs or a full replacement. It presents a safety hazard to users, as the metal is rusting away.

John Rogers requests that the City look into the above concerns. Also, he would like an update regarding the status of the City's irrigation efforts for the West Loch bike path which the City had agreed to undertake in their agreement with the West Loch Fairways Association.
